## Why we're needed

- A spinal cord injury (SCI) can happen to anyone at any time and it is one of the most traumatic events to occur in an individual's life
- There are 350-400 new spinal cord injuries every year in Ontario – that is almost one Ontarian sustaining an injury every day
- Current estimates indicate there are approximately 12,000 Ontarians living with a SCI
- The highest incidence of injury is to individuals under the age of 35
- The cost of a SCI to the Canadian healthcare system can be between \$1.25-\$25 million over an individual's lifetime depending on severity of injury

# 2006-2007 Chair and Executive Director's Report

Helping people living with a spinal cord injury (SCI) achieve independence, self-reliance and full community participation is our #1 priority.

---

It is an exciting time at CPA Ontario as we increase our capacity to reach and serve more people than ever before. Our revenues increased substantially this year, led by a new annual investment of \$600,000 from the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care to support province-wide service expansion. As we grow, we remain steadfast in our devotion to client centered services, while increasing our commitment to meet new accountability expectations, and high standards of excellence for governance of a nonprofit organization.

Over the past year, we have dramatically expanded our services, reaching more clients, providing more hours of service, and raising more funds than ever before. We exceeded our goal of reaching clients living with a SCI by 36% for a total of 824 served! We served a total of 1,305 clients and responded to 2,826 information requests. Peer Support provided services to 169 individuals living with SCI and to 150 families. 67 clients returned to the workforce with the support of CPA Ontario. We more than doubled the number of our volunteers to 1,654 who provided an impressive 15,391 hours of service. Our success is topped off with each and every salaried staff and each Board Director at CPA Ontario making a financial contribution to support our work.

During the year, the 100 clients using CPA Ontario Attendant Services reported an overall satisfaction rate of 92%. Indeed, this success is a fitting way to mark the 20th anniversary of CPA Ontario's Attendant Service program,

which was initiated under the pioneering leadership of the late Darrell Murphy.

Our Regional Service Coordinators are establishing best practices for our community based services across Ontario, while continuing to assist clients to access essential services and acquire equipment to enhance their quality of life and independence.

Employment Services is busy planning its 25th Anniversary celebration in 2007! CPA Ontario's Employment Centre, located at, and delivered in partnership with Toronto Rehab Lyndhurst Centre, officially opened its doors on October 15, 1997. From 1997 to the present day, more than 750 clients have obtained gainful employment. This past year, clients reported a satisfaction rate of 95%.

We are delighted to be forging strong relationships with the 14 Local Health Integration Networks (LHINs) in Ontario, as we actively increase collaboration with allied service agencies throughout the province. Our Mission, Vision and Strategic Priorities used in the past to guide CPA Ontario are directly in line with the Ontario government's Health Transformation Agenda to increase results and accountability. CPA Ontario is developing a new three year plan that will identify partnership opportunities to improve coordination among service providers, promote client centered services across the entire SCI system and increase accountability through results reporting.

Throughout the year, we helped shape a SCI network at the national level in

partnership with the Rick Hansen Solutions in Motion Alliance. Recognizing the advantages of uniting efforts in our home province, CPA Ontario and the Ontario Neurotrauma Foundation have formed a partnership to develop an Ontario SCI Solutions Alliance. This Alliance will provide a forum where stakeholders in the SCI field, including people living with SCI, will join forces to implement a province-wide SCI strategy, customized for Ontario. At the regional level in Ontario, CPA Ontario and Hamilton Health Sciences have formed a partnership to build, implement and evaluate a model SCI support system within the Hamilton Niagara Haldeman Brant Local Health Integration Network area. The Ontario Neurotrauma Foundation, Rick Hansen Foundation and McMaster University have also joined this exciting project.

Fundraising is essential to facilitate the delivery of vital CPA Ontario services, and our Resources Development Department exceeded their target this year by \$88,218. Our Community Development Coordinators have been busy across the province, creating and managing fund-raising events like the annual No Limits Dinner (Hamilton) and the Champagne Charity Auction (Ottawa). Activities which helped raise nearly \$1.8 million during 2006-2007 included ten wheelchair relays across the province, of which our largest event in Toronto broke its all time participation and fundraising results; Ski and Snowboard Day; a new residential canvassing program; and several annual golf events including the Barbara Turnbull Open Golf Tournament, Swing Your Sticks (Owen Sound), and Cam Mingay's Annual Charity Golf Tournament. Our year was highlighted by a new event held in partnership with The Canadian Tour and sponsored by the Dominion of Canada General Insurance Co., who also sponsored a very successful Curling Bonsel for CPA Ontario.

We staged three Knowledge Mobilization Seminars during the year. Each one was attended by well over 150 people. Funds from our generous sponsors enabled us to video the

sessions and post them on our website for viewing by members who were not able to attend. Dedicated to knowledge transfer, we released seven research reports containing valuable information to enhance the quality of life of people living with a SCI.

CPA Ontario ended the fiscal year March 31, 2007 with a surplus of \$1,485.

On March 7, CPA Ontario's Board of Directors approved the largest ever annual operating budget for the fiscal year that begins April 1, 2007 – over \$8.5 million! For the first time, we plan to reach more than 300 Ontarians who experience a new SCI during the year. The number of clients we serve will increase by over 30%; an impressive advance in achieving our mission. Service expansion is being fueled by an impressive 14% increase in fundraising revenue! As our services expand, we also will have increased capacity to advocate for changes in Ontario. This will advance equal opportunity for our members to fully participate in the rights and obligations of citizenship, and promote the creation of welcoming communities throughout our great province.

CPA Ontario invites your participation as we continue our ongoing quest to support independence, self-reliance and full community participation for all people living with a SCI across Ontario. We thank you all for your immense contribution to this worthy cause over the past year, and we look forward to your involvement in meeting the challenges ahead.

# Highlights 2006-2007

## Reaching 100% of People with SCI

- Successfully reached **824** people with a SCI

- Developed a strategy to reach and serve Francophone Ontarians with a SCI for implementation in 2007
- Began a discussion with the Aboriginal community to do a needs analysis and develop plans for assistance
- Initiated a SCI Network Coordinator role to integrate service, link communities across the province, and enhance outreach
- Provided people with SCI in the Greater Toronto Area with unique devices through the Gizmo Program, by partnering with the Tetra Society
- Worked with the Ontario Brain Injury Association to explore alternative methods / strategies for the delivery of Peer Support; particularly in remote areas
- Trained **21** new Peer Support volunteers
- Welcomed **432** new members who joined the organization (over **30%** increase in new memberships)



- The 2nd Annual Sex, Wheels & Relationships Forum was held in Toronto, and for the first time in Hamilton

# CPA Ontario 2006-2007 Treasurer's Report

## **Abridged Financial Statements**

It is my pleasure to report on CPA Ontario's financial results for the year ended March 31, 2007.

## **Funding**

To obtain stable, diversified funding is one of CPA Ontario's four strategic priorities and significant progress was made in this area during the 2006/2007 year. Grant funding increased by 18% to over \$5.6 million due to the receipt of an additional \$600,000 of annualized funding from the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care. With this additional funding, CPA Ontario was able to increase service delivery in Windsor/Chatham, South East Ontario and Parry Sound/Muskoka and set the foundation for future service expansion through initiatives such as aboriginal service development, francophone engagement, leadership planning in Champlain and South West areas, community development work in northern Ontario, resources for Direct Aid to clients and various infrastructure improvements.

Donations and other public support ended the year at nearly \$1.8 million. This is a remarkable achievement considering that last year's Summer Fling fundraising gala (which had raised \$235,000 in fiscal 2006) was not held in fiscal 2007 but is planned instead as a Dirty Dancing theatre event in fiscal 2008. During the year, efforts were focused on developing and expanding fundraising events in communities across Ontario, and stewarding relationships with our community and corporate partners.

The strong fundraising results and increased Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care funding meant that CPA Ontario drew only \$6,000 from the Ontario Paraplegic Foundation this year, versus the \$270,000 that had been budgeted to draw from the Foundation for operating and research. Therefore, although Donations and other public support are lower than last year, this is actually a good news message and speaks to CPA Ontario's solid financial footing.


## **Financial Status**

Overall, CPA Ontario had an extremely successful year. Total revenues for the year ended March 31, 2007 increased by 9% to over \$7.6 million. Operating expenses, primarily due to the expansion of services, increased by 9% or \$638,000. Our cash position increased by \$213,000, due mainly to the receipt of revenues that have been deferred for recognition in future years. Fixed asset purchases – primarily computers, office equipment and furniture – amounted to \$349,000 of which \$67,104 was internally funded.

CPA Ontario finished the year with a modest operating surplus of \$1,485.

Our success depends greatly on the generous support from our volunteers, donors and staff. On behalf of the Finance Committee, thank you for your ongoing commitment to CPA Ontario.
